Pre-departure

Guests travelling from O. R. Tambo International Airport (JNB) to Seychelles

All travellers must complete the Exit Screening Traveller Health Questionnaire on Page 3, Prior to leaving South Africa.

The test must be taken not more than 72 hours before departure. For entry into Seychelles, all travellers, including infants and children, must have a negative COVID-19 PCR certificate.

All travellers must submit the mandatory Health Travel Authorisation (HTA) via seychelles.govtas.com for approval prior to entering the country (includes children and infants. You will be required to submit your PCR results, a selfie, your passport details, hotel confirmation for your entire stay, other relevant information as well as a payment card to complete the application. If vaccinated, please provide authentic vaccination card/certificate.

The HTA fees are EUR 10 for standard application and EUR 70 for expedited applications for 12 years and above. EUR 5.40 for infants and children from 0-11 years old.

Please ensure you complete this process immediately after you have your PCR results.

Onboard

- Passengers will be advised to board the aircraft by rows, in a specific numerical order, as per their assigned seat.
- Each passenger will undergo one temperature screening at the aircraft door before final boarding approval is given.
- Masks will be required for everyone (6 years and above).
- Blankets and pillows will be available.
- Streaming in-flight entertainment will be available on your own device.
- Meal service from JNB-SEZ is a hot dinner.
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- Complimentary cold and hot beverages will be served.

Measures taken

- Disinfecting surfaces after every flight.
- The cleaning process includes a wipe down of surfaces and areas such as windows, tray tables, armrests, seats, air vents and overhead lockers in the cabin, lavatories, galleys and crew rest areas.

Arrival in Seychelles

- Upon landing, passengers will need to follow the disembarkation instructions as advised by the cabin crew and observe the health and safety measures set by the authorities at the country of destination.
- Disembarkation will be done in groups as instructed by the cabin crew.
- The HTA can be presented in a form of hard or soft copy. Permitted hard copies are a paper print out and soft copies are Mobile app/ Apple Passbook.
- You may be randomly selected for additional COVID-19 health tests.
- Facemasks are mandatory. Observe COVID-19 safety rules.

COVID-19 PCR testing facilities are available for visitors before departure on Mahé, Praslin and La Digue. Your hotel can provide you with more information about PCR testing in Seychelles.

Air Seychelles offers all its passengers special COVID-19 PCR and Antigen testing rates at the following centre upon presenting valid Air Seychelles tickets and Passports:

- **Located on Eden Island. Blue Building (Between Bravo Restaurant & The Boardwalk Bar & Grill)**
- **RT-PCR test costs SCR 1,700 per person. Test results will be available within 18 hours.**
- **Express RT-PCR test costs SCR 2,500 per person. Test results will be available within 8 hours.**
- **Antigen test costs SCR 1,000 per person. Test results will be available within 2 hours.**
