Pre-departure

Guests travelling from Seychelles to Mumbai International Airport

All travellers are required to take a COVID-19 PCR test not more than 72 hours before departure and another on arrival. On-arrival molecular test will cost approximately INR 850 per person. All travellers must carry a hard copy of the negative COVID-19 PCR certificate test at the time of departure. Digital copies will not be allowed. Certificate should be in English, specifying name of passenger and the outcome of the test.

All travellers, including children and infants, must submit a self-declaration form (SDF) under the Air Suvidha section on the online portal (<https://www.newdelhiairport.in/>) prior to departure, also stating complete contact details and address. It must be clearly mentioned on the SDF whether Mumbai is the final destination or disembarking will be for transit to onward flights.

Transit passengers must present the "T" (Transit) receipt to the authority/ Government of India. Travellers must also declare if they have a travel history to United Kingdom, Brazil or South Africa in the past 14 days. All travellers must carry printed copies of the self-declaration form.

Travellers must submit an undertaking form on the online portal (<https://www.newdelhiairport.in/>) agreeing to follow advice by the government authority to undergo home quarantine or self-monitoring of their health for 14 days or as mandated. Quarantine exemptions may be awarded on special circumstances or to travellers arriving with onward domestic connection provided the passport address indicate an address outside the state of Maharashtra.

Passengers under the following exceptional circumstances would be considered for exemption from the 7-day mandatory institutional quarantine. The exemption will be decided upon arrival and verification of supporting documents.

All passengers must download the Aarogya Setu App (<https://www.mygov.in/aarogya-setu-app/>) on their mobile devices.

Please check the requirements before you travel as the travel regulations change frequently.

Onboard

- Passengers will be advised to board the aircraft by rows, in a specific numerical order, as per their assigned seat.
- Each passenger will undergo one temperature screening at the aircraft door before final boarding approval is given.
- Masks will be required for everyone (6 years and above).
- Blankets and pillows will be available.
- Streaming in-flight entertainment will be available on your own device.
- Meal service is available on all flights with complimentary alcohol and hot drinks.

Arrival in Mumbai

- Upon landing, passengers will need to observe the health and safety measures set by the authorities.
- Face masks are mandatory.
- Observe social distancing and COVID-19 safety rules.

Measures taken

- Disinfecting surfaces after every flight.
- The cleaning process includes a wipe down of surfaces and areas such as windows, tray tables, armrests, seats, air vents and overhead lockers in the cabin, lavatories, galleys and crew rest areas.
